SCORING AT A GLANCE

General Scoring Information

- Grade-band specific rubrics, not task specific rubrics
- Each grade-band will have one speaking rubric used on all tasks
- Each grade-band will have one writing rubric used on all tasks
- Rater training materials include writing and speaking example responses and calibration materials
- Districts scoring decision – deferred scoring or simultaneous scoring; calibration process within the district to ensure scores are on point and reflective of the rubric

Training
