TEST records for ELA, Math and Science:

- Can be submitted at any point during testing, but you will need to allow 24 hours for the processing from KIDS to the Kite system to be in place.

KAP Summative Assessment Projected Testing Schedule

Please take time to enter your testing schedule in the Kite Educator Portal!

The projected testing section of the **manage tests menu** provides assessment coordinators the ability to **view projected testing volume system wide** and to **upload and manage their own testing schedule**. It also helps manage testing volume at the state level

Provides – Student login, test records and PNP settings.

KAP Summative Assessment

Daily Access Codes (DAC):

- Are a unique code that allows students to launch each test in the Kite Student Portal.
- Are to be maintained as “**secure**” – DTCs are responsible for making sure secure transmission of these codes happens within their school district.

KAP Summative Assessment

Daily Access Codes (DAC):

- Daily Access Codes can be retrieved from **Educator Portal** beginning at 2:30 p.m. the day before testing day and the entire day of testing.

PNPs:

- Should have been entered in Educator Portal before February 25.
- New Abridged Extract for uploading PNPs
- Test Readiness Extract allows you to view all PNPs

KELPA2 Key Dates

Administration and Scoring

- The KELPA2 **testing window** is being **extended to March 22**. All testing must be completed by 5:00 pm on March 22.
- The **scoring window IS NOT CHANGING!** Scoring must be completed by 5:00 pm on March 29.
- **SC coding** deadline for KELPA2 **IS NOT CHANGING!** All SC coding must be completed by March 22.

KELPA2 Test Administration and Scoring Directions for Writing Teacher Directions, Student Assessment, and Scoring Information Question Rubric Revised - Feb. 12, 2019 - Questions 5, 12 and 16 **The rubric for these questions was mislabeled.** The rubric that should be used to score these items is correct in the paper document provided on the HELP tab **and has always been correct** – it was just mislabeled. **You do not need to rescore these items.**

Scoring

Upon completion of testing the psychometric team at CETE will analyze performance on all items. If a problem is discovered in any items/scoring rubrics that are brought to our attention we will pull the item from the final assessment score so that the item will not count for or against students.
