 - Usernames and passwords – are the same for all KAP tests
- TEST sends for KELPA2 and KAP summative assessments

KAP Summative Assessment

- Kansas Assessment Examiner's Manual (KAEM) available – www.ksassessments.org
- **TEST records** must be submitted to KIDS for the spring assessments and PNPs entered in Educator Portal by **February 25**.
- **SC codes** must be entered in Educator Portal by **April 19**. Refer to KAEM pages 10-13
- Results (student, building and district **reports**) will be available in Educator Portal the week of **May 5**.



- DLM assessment results will be available in June.
- Develop a plan to distribute individual student score reports and parent letters for KAP assessments and DLM assessments

KAP Interim Predictive and Interim Mini-tests

- TASC records must be submitted to KIDS with teacher ID and name in the proctor field for the Predictive Interim Assessments and the Interim Mini-Tests to be accessed by students and for reports to be available to staff. The spring predictive window is 02/04/19 – 02/15/19.
- The mini-tests should not be used as practice tests for the summative assessment. Mini-tests should be administered after classroom instruction has been provided and you want to check for understanding.

English Language Proficiency Standards

These standards were strategically designed to streamline the process of learning in English and meeting college-and-career-ready standards in academic subject areas by allowing students to gain English proficiency and learn other subjects at the same time. KELPA2 assessments are broken into four parts corresponding with the four domains reflected in the English Language Proficiency Standards: reading, listening, speaking, and writing.

KELPA2 assessments are entirely computer-based for students in grade 2 and beyond. K-1 students take a mostly computer-based exam but also complete a small number of writing items by hand. Assessments are delivered through Kite Client every spring along with regular KAP assessments.
