## Kansas Assessment Program

### May 2026

The following features are included in the most recent release of Kite® Educator Portal.

#### New features:

- **Enhancement to Mini Test Management** – In the fall, Educators will be able to discontinue Mini Tests they have created, as long as the test has not been assigned to any students. Discontinued Mini Tests will be removed from both the Assign Tests and Copy a Test tables. Mini Tests will be discontinued by selecting the test from the Copy a Test screen.
- **Cell Phone Number Field added to My Profile** – A new cell phone number field has been added to My Profile in Educator Portal, allowing users to add or update their own cell phone number. Beginning next school year, this cell phone number may be used as an optional method for receiving multi-factor authentication (MFA) codes. Email will remain the primary and default method for MFA delivery. The cell phone number field can be enabled or disabled by state and assessment program, providing flexibility in determining who has access to add this information.

#### Updated features:

- **KAP Report Updates** – Text and formatting improvements have been applied to the 2026 KAP Summative Individual Student Reports, as well as the District and School Reports, to improve clarity and readability.
