Kansas Assessment Program (KAP) April 2023

The following features have been included since the last major release of Kite® Educator Portal and Kite Student Portal.

New features:

- **KELPA School and District Reports** – New KELPA School and District Summary reports are available to building and district test coordinators. They can be accessed from the tabs in the Reports menu > English Language Learners Assessment. Excerpts from an example report are shown below.
- **Special Circumstance Students Dashboard** – The KAP Dashboard now includes the Special Circumstance (SC) Students tab that lists students assigned an SC Code. The table on the dashboard has a row for each code entered and includes information about the subject and grade of the assessment, what SC Code was assigned, and the status of each test session for that particular assessment.
- **Grade 2 Reading Pilot** – Updates were made to Educator Portal to support the Spring 2023 pilot of the new KAP Grade 2 Reading assessment. This assessment will be operational for the 2023-2024 school year. Districts interested in participating should contact the Kite Service Desk.

Updated features:

- **Math Grade 8 Spring Interim** – The Grade 8 Math Predictive Interim assessment was copied from the winter to spring to give districts another chance to engage their 8th grade math students. The associated reports were also updated to indicate that this assessment was the same as the one given in the winter.
- **Column Freezing** – The Students table and Monitoring table are now more user-friendly! As users scroll horizontally within the table, the student name and/or SSID columns will freeze on the left side of the table. Thank you to the user who suggested this update! We hope you find the information more easily accessible.
- **KELPA Screener Status Extract Update** – The KELPA Screener Status data extract has been extended to include a column for an assessed student's proficiency status if they completed the assessment. This will allow districts to quickly see if students *are* or *are not* proficient and also assist them in updating their own data systems as needed.

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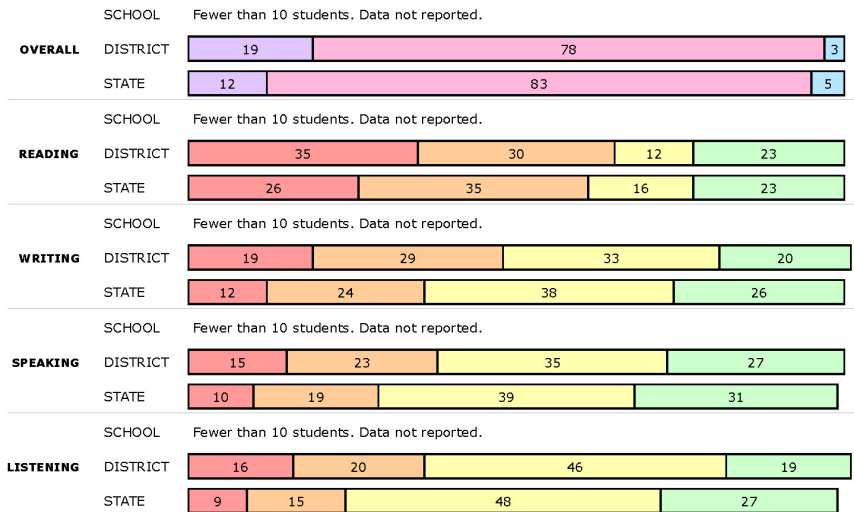
