



# Vector Minor Release 4 Notes

The following features are included in the most recent release of Kite® Educator Portal and Kite® Student Portal.

## New features:

- **Standards Based Report** – This is a dynamic report that allows educators to view individual student performance by standard or by cluster. The results are an aggregate of item-level performance on the Interim Assessment and Instructional Mini Tests the student has completed.
- **KAP Interim Interactive Reports** – The Interim View Interactive Reports option allows educators to break down the Interim assessment results by grouping. Three reports are available including Area Performance, Item Performance and Individual Student Performance.
- **Student Bundling Across Multiple Test Windows** – KAP users with the appropriate permissions can now bundle student reports within a window or across multiple windows. This can be completed by accessing the “Common Bundled Reports” section of Educator Portal by selecting Reports and then Common Bundled Reports.
- **School Readiness Tool** – An additional tool for schools to use to check their network’s bandwidth. This tool will help determine if there is adequate bandwidth for the number of students they plan to test at one time. Having this information in advance can assist in planning or adjusting testing schedules, if needed, to ensure smooth testing for students.

## Updated features:

- **Review a Test Update** – In order to allow students to interact with media and text stimulus, an update was made to allow students to interact with test content and questions, however, this does not update the student response. If a student selects a new response while using the Review a Test option and then moves to the following question the newly selected response is not saved.
