## Kansas Assessment Program January 2025

The following features are included in the most recent release of Kite<sup>®</sup> Educator Portal and Kite<sup>®</sup> Student Portal.

## New features:

- KAP Spring Interim Reports The Spring KAP Interim Family Report has been updated to include a table that was available on the previous year's Interim reports, which includes question descriptions and a breakdown of student performance on each question. Additionally, similar to last year, the Interim Question Report will be available in CSV Format, with the question descriptions and student performance breakdown for each Interim question.
- KELPA Speaking Play Button Disabled While Student is Recording The question spoken audio play button is disabled on KELPA Speaking items while the student is recording their response.

## Updated features:

- N-Size added to Interim Interactive Reports The N-value represents the number of students who started the Interim assessment in each group (roster, school, district and state). This value can be found in the table column header on the Area Performance and Item Performance tabs.
- KELPA Reports Domain Order Update On the KELPA reports for 2025, the order the domains appear on the report have been updated to appear in alphabetical order.
- Click History Updates Enhancements audit data captured for student actions within the Student Portal. These include the usage of the divider pane on split view (passage and question) items, when ASL videos are used, toggling between passage and question views, as well as app navigation outside of testing (Home, Take a Test, Practice First, Review a Test, Close Kite).
