


KAP Practice Tests – Parent Guide

Students in grades 3–11 take Kansas summative assessments each year. These assessments measure how well students are learning the Kansas academic standards in ELA (grades 3-8 and 10), Mathematics (grades 3–8, 10), and Science (grades 5, 8, 11). Parents and families can explore these assessments online to see what the testing system looks like and the types of questions students may encounter. This preview allows adults to experience the Kite® testing platform used by students during the Kansas state assessments.

These preview tests are intended to help families see the assessment platform and examples of question types. They are not required for students to complete at home.

What Parents Can Explore

- **Kite Student Portal** - The system students use to take the Kansas state assessments. Parents can see how students move through questions, navigate the test, and submit their answers.
- **Types of Questions** - Examples include multiple-choice questions, drag-and-drop questions, matching lines, and reading passages with related questions.
- **Available Tools** - Students may use tools such as a highlighter, zoom, line reader (guideline), notepad, striker, resource sheets, and calculators (on certain math tests).



What Practice Tests Are Available?

Several types of practice tests are available in the Kite Student Portal. Each allows parents and students to explore different parts of the testing system and see examples of the types of questions used in Kansas assessments.

- **Technology Practice Tests** – Basic items that allow students to practice the technology used to answer questions in Kite Student Portal. Examples include matching lines, drag-and-drop items, and other interactive question types.
- **KELPA Practice Tests** – Sample items similar to those used on the Kansas English Language Proficiency Assessment (KELPA) summative assessment. Students can see examples from the reading, writing, speaking, and listening domains.
- **KAP Practice Tests** – A variety of item types like those used on KAP tests.
- **KAP Practice Tests with Tools** – Same items as the KAP Practice Tests but also provide access to several accessibility tools such as magnification and text-to-speech.
- **Braille Practice Tests** – Items similar to those used on KAP assessments but only include item types available on forms designed for students who use braille or screen readers.
- **Grade 2 Reading Practice Test** – Items similar to those used on the Grade 2 Reading assessment.

How do I access KAP Practice Tests?

1. Go to <https://student.kiteaai.org>.
2. On the login page, enter a username and password from the tables below.
3. Select **Sign In**.
4. Select **Practice First** on the home screen.
5. Select **Technology, KELPA, KAP, KAP with Tools, Braille, or Grade 2 Reading**.
6. Find the practice test you want and select **Take Test**.
