



The mathematics assessment asks students to use, analyze, and perform operations with numbers, equations, and expressions with both real-world and mathematical problems. Please discuss the following results with Sean's teacher.

How is Sean doing in different areas of mathematics?


Below is how Sean performed in the different aspects of mathematics measured by this assessment. These areas are only reported when at least a total score of 5 is possible. Because of this fact, the sum of these areas may not equal the overall score above.



Operations & Algebraic Thinking

In this area, students represent and solve mathematical problems involving multiplication and division by:

- interpreting products of whole numbers, such as 5 x 7 is the total number of objects in 5 groups of 7,
- interpreting quotients of whole numbers, such as 30 apples divided into 5 equal groups means there are 6 apples per group,
- multiplying and dividing within 100 to solve word problems, and
- \bullet determining the unknown whole number in a multiplication or division equation, such as 6 \times ? = 48.



Number & Operations

In this area, students use their understanding of place value to solve problems by:

- rounding whole numbers to the nearest 10 or 100, and
- fluently adding and subtracting within 1000.







PreACT 8/9



- All answer documents must be received by ACT by November 22 to be scored.
- As scoring is completed, results are posted in Success.
- Reports that are mailed to schools are sent approximately two weeks after answer documents are scored.



WorkKeys

- If you tested in the fall, see Section 7 under the WorkKeys tab on the Kansas ACT website for reporting information.
 - Reports are being posted in the Online Reports Portal as scoring is completed.
 - Refer to the Online Reports Portal User Guide to access reports through Validus.
- Spring testing: Select test dates and chose paper or online before December 6.
 - If you are testing on paper, submit the SDU to enroll your students before January 17.
 - For online testing, enroll students through Validus, set up testing sessions and test January 29-April 21.
- Refer to the Schedule of Events and the Kansas ACT website for timelines, instructions and training opportunities.

ACT



- The final deadline for submitting Test Accessibility and Accommodations System (TAA) requests is January 10.
- Select test dates before December 6.
