## KAP Summative Testing Window 2025

Reminder:

- Special Circumstance Codes must be added to the student's test in Kite before the testing window closes.
- SC Code 08 and 39 must be approved before window closes.

#### Why a Revised and Enhanced Test This Year?



- •Teachers and administrators asked for a shorter test
- •The standards needed reprioritized based on current education needs
- Technology has changed drastically over the last 10 years
- Overall Performance Level Descriptors were not clearly defined



# What Has Changed?



- •The 2025 tests will have all new items
- More technology enhanced items rather than multiple choice
- •ELA tests will be passage-based
- •Allow us to provide vertical alignment between grades
- New Performance Level Descriptors



#### 2015-24 State Assessment Performance Level Descriptors

- •A student at <u>Level 1</u> shows a **limited** ability to understand and use the English language arts (mathematics, science) skills and knowledge needed for postsecondary readiness.
- •A student at <u>Level 2</u> shows a **basic** ability to understand and use the English language arts (mathematics, science) skills and knowledge needed for postsecondary readiness.
- •A student at <u>Level 3</u> shows an **effective** ability to understand and use the English language arts (mathematics, science) skills and knowledge needed for postsecondary readiness.
- •A student at <u>Level 4</u> shows an **excellent** ability to understand and use the English language arts (mathematics, science) skills and knowledge needed for postsecondary readiness.



#### 2025 Proposed State Assessment Performance Level Descriptors

- •A student at <u>Level 1</u> shows a **limited** ability to demonstrate their knowledge and skills of (third, fourth, fifth, etc.) grade (ELA, Math, Science) standards.
- •A student at <u>Level 2</u> shows a **basic** ability to demonstrate their knowledge and skills of (third, fourth, fifth, etc.) grade (ELA, Math, Science) standards.
- •A student at <u>Level 3</u> shows a **proficient** ability to demonstrate their knowledge and skills of (third, fourth, fifth, etc.) grade (ELA, Math, Science) standards.
- •A student at <u>Level 4</u> shows an **advanced** ability to demonstrate their knowledge and skills of (third, fourth, fifth, etc.) grade (ELA, Math, Science) standards.

### District Test Coordinator Responsibilities



- 1. **OVERSEE** test security for the entire district.
- 2. **ESTABLISH AND IMPLEMENT** test security and ethics procedures for the district.
- **3. TRAIN ALL STAFF** through in-person training before testing begins.
  - 1. This includes training in test security procedures, ethics of testing, and reporting and documenting accommodations.

Refer to the KSDE Test Security Guidelines (pdf) for a complete list of responsibilities.

# Physical Conditions in Testing Room



- Monitor the testing environment actively by moving around the room; moving around the room encourages students to focus on their own work.
- Testing environment should be quiet without background music.
- Students should not have cell phones, smart watches, or any technology devices other than the device in which they are testing.

# A human reader is <u>not</u> an allowed accommodation on the KAP assessment.



## Added Changes to Remote Testing



- KAP Summative Remote Testing Manual
  - oTEST records submitted by March 14
  - o 1 test session = 1 scheduled session with Monitor EDU (p.10&11)
  - Teacher must schedule virtual meeting just prior to students testing. (~15 minutes)
    - Read scripts.
    - Reinforce security protocol.
    - Student login
    - MonitorEDU link



# Special Circumstance Codes



- Enter once the window opens but before the window closes.
- Directions located on page 39 of <u>KAP Test Coordinator Manual</u>
- KSDE approval required for SC-08 and SC-39 BEFORE April 25.
- If you already marked this in Kite, you will still need an approved application from KSDE.
- SC-08 and SC-39 change
  - o Email <u>chelsea.pelfrey@ksde.gov</u> for the form.



# PNPs and Text to Speech



- PNPs can only be edited by DTCs now that the window is open.
- Text to Speech for 3rd 5th grades is ONLY available to those with an approved TTS Passages and Graphics application from KSDE.
- Do not enter Text to Speech for these grades if you did not submit an application.



## Optional 2nd Grade Reading Assessment



- Voluntary assessment for 2nd Grade
- Administered in Kite Student Portal
- Assess both skills and reading comprehension
- Based on state standards
- 2 sections, 30 minutes per section
- Score reports available after window closes
- TASC record to roster students


- Reminder:
  - o Add State Student Identifier (SSID) to KELPA Screener students
    - Connects Screener Student to TEST Enrollment Record
    - Retains KELPA Screener proficiency report associated with the SSID
  - Two ways to add the SSID
    - Manually: Settings > Screener Student > View Student > Edit
    - <u>Upload/Link Student</u>: Settings > Screener Student > Upload/Link Student > Upload updated KELPA Screener Student file

    - Use this check box if you are screening a student for the following school year
    - Settings > Screener Students > Add Student







# **PNP Settings**



- Now that the KAP Summative Test Window is open only the District Test Coordinator can modify Student PNP settings.
  - District Users, Building Test Coordinators, Building Users, and Teachers can view the PNP settings, but they cannot make edits



# **Testing Readiness**



- How to verify students are ready to take the KAP Summative assessment?
  - ☐ Go to Reports > Data Extracts > Test Administration and Monitoring tab > Testing Readiness > Select "New File"


## Daily Access Codes – Set by District/School


#### Reactivate

  - o Reactivate one session or two at a time

 Reactivations are not commonly needed as students should use the Save button in Kite Student Portal if they cannot complete the test in

one sitting.





## **Spring Test Window**



#### **ELA/math**

- Grades 3-8 and 10
- Must meet blueprint requirement in ELA and math assign testlets through instruction and assessment planner; access testlet information page through instruction and assessment planner.

#### <u>Science</u>

- Grades 5, 8, and 11
- Must test on all 9 Essential Elements testlets are assigned one at a time by the system; access testlet information page through test management instead of the instruction and assessment planner.

## Special Circumstance Codes



- SC codes need to be entered for each subject
- Student must be rostered, first contact survey complete, and one testlet assigned before an SC code can be entered.
- Special Circumstance Codes for Kansas Districts (PDF)
- For SC-08 and SC-39 require the Special Circumstance Exemption Form completed and sent to <a href="mailto:chelsea.pelfrey@ksde.gov">chelsea.pelfrey@ksde.gov</a>.




#### Field Test Testlets



- •ELA and Mathematics after completing the blueprint requirements, the student may receive one field test testlet in each of these subjects.
- •Science after all required science testlets are completed, the student may receive one science field test testlet.
- •Testlet Information Pages for field test testlets for all subjects are accessed in the Test Management section.

## **Teacher Survey Reminders**



- The survey opens when the spring testing window opens.
- •It is available in Student Portal under the Other tab.
- Completion is optional.
- □□•Survey completion is not associated with testlet assignment.
- •Teachers can complete the survey at any time, but we recommend completing it after students take testlets.



# Writing Samples - Spring Window Only

- Step by step directions with screen shots for submitting writing samples <u>Submitting Student Writing Samples in Educator</u> <u>Portal</u> (PDF)
- •Samples are used for validity evidence and research purposes; uploading a writing sample does not impact scoring.
- •Submitting writing samples is not required, however, we do encourage teachers to try and submit the writing samples for at least a couple students.

### **ACT and WorkKeys Spring 2025**

ACT

- Test Window 2 standard paper is complete.
- Online testing and accommodations testing ends Friday.
- Window 3 for standard paper make-up testing is April 22 and online testing will be available April 22-May 2
- WorkKeys
  - Test Window 2 standard paper testing is complete.
  - Accommodations paper testing ends April 21.
  - You may test online until April 21.



### ACT, PreACT 8/9 and WorkKeys 2025-2026

- Exciting News for 2025-2026!
  - ACT is migrating ACT, PreACT and WorkKeys to a new platform called ACT Now. States are being phased in and Kansas is in the final group.
  - Kansas starts the migration with PreACT 8/9 and WorkKeys in fall 2025 and then ACT in spring 2026.
  - Reporting will also be updated so all of these assessments will be reported in Success.
- Watch for additional information this spring and summer.
  - ACT will send information directly to test coordinators later this spring and summer.
  - KSDE will send additional information on the Test Coordinators listserv as we start preparing for fall testing.
