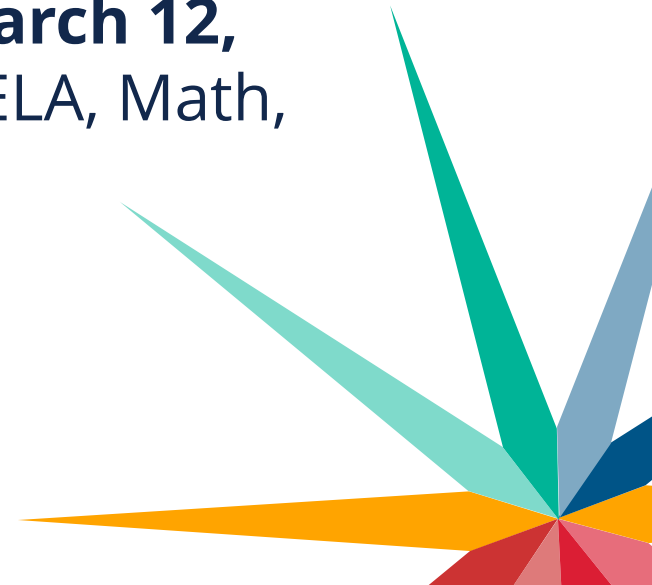

Security and Ethics Training

- All District Test Coordinators must complete *in-person* Security and Ethics training held by KSDE and train staff before testing.
- All in-person district training must be completed before February 1, 2027, for anyone administering a **KELPA** assessment.
- All in-person district training must be completed by **March 12, 2026**, for anyone administering a **KAP** assessment in ELA, Math, Science, and/or cPass.



Test Coordinator Responsibilities

- Communication
- Update roles in Kite Educator Portal
- Complete Annual Test Security and Ethics Training
 - Train all staff involved with testing before the window opens



Kite Clean Up

- Updates roles in Educator Portal
 - Deactivate staff who are no longer in the district
 - Claim staff from other districts OR add new Kite users
- New DTCs
 - Make sure you have filled out the form sent out

KELPA Screener - FAQs

- Do I need to complete manual scoring?
 - Students who complete Session 3 must be scored by the test administrator.
 - Students who only complete Session 1 or 2 do not require manual scoring.
- When to use the "Reassign" option?
 - Added with an incorrect grade
 - Assigned to the wrong teacher before testing is started
 - Student changed schools
- How to reassign?
 - Download the Screener Student Extract > Make any needed changes > Enter "YES" in column J for the student > Upload in EP

KS Alternate Early Literacy Screener

- The Kansas Alternate Early Literacy Screener is a simple rubric that assesses students' early literacy skills as they relate to skill domains within English Language Arts (print concepts, phonological awareness, phonics and word recognition, fluency and comprehension). The rubric is meant to be completed for each student with a Significant Cognitive Disability (grades K-3) by their teacher, based on the student's performance on Individualized Education Program (IEP) goals and every day early literacy instruction within the classroom.



Who takes the Alternate Screener?

- Student is in grades Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, or 3rd grade; and
- Student has a most significant cognitive disability that significantly impacts intellectual functioning and adaptive behavior; and
- Student is learning content linked to the DLM Essential Elements; and
- Student requires extensive, repeated, direct individualized instruction and substantial supports to achieve measurable gains in the grade-and-age-appropriate curriculum, and
- Determined by the IEP team.



Kansas Alternate Literacy Screener Changes

KSDE Dyslexia Screening Protocol Reporting,

- Screening data will be received via the KEDS platform. The deadline for fall is **October 10, 2026**. Deadline for spring is **May 28, 2027**.
- The scoring guide will be used to determine high risk, some risk, or at benchmark based on the student's overall score on the score sheet for the student's grade – refer to the score sheet and scoring guide for the specific grade.
- Due to the changes in reporting for fall and spring, **8th grade comprehension will not be reported during the 2026-2027 school year.**
- KSDE is in the process of building out the Alternate Literacy Screener for grades 4th through 8th grade which will be used for the 2027-2028 school year.

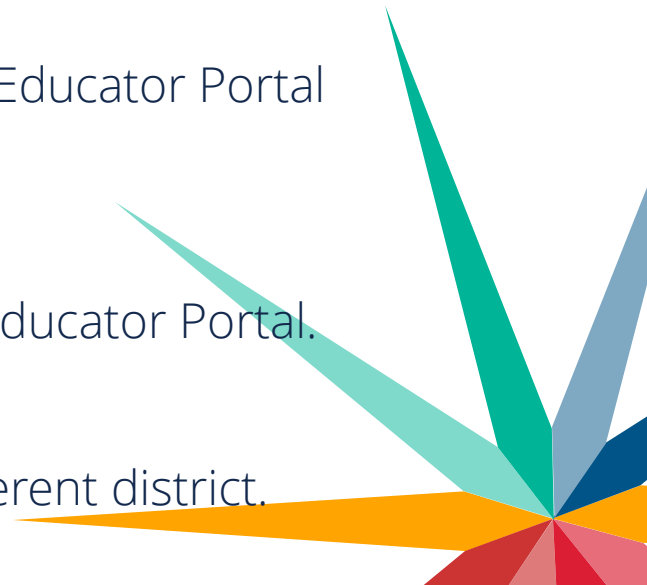

Fall WorkKeys

Test date selection is due by August 21.

- You must select test dates to indicate you are planning to test fall WorkKeys. Selecting those dates does not determine if you are testing on paper or online. Your student enrollment determines that.
- If you plan to test on paper, submit the Student Data Upload Template(SDU) to enroll students for paper testing. The SDU submission creates a standard paper order. Verify enrollment and select accommodations materials needed.
- For online testing, Validus information will be sent to your building test coordinators on September 2. They may then enroll students through Validus and create online testing sessions. Online testing may be completed any time September 30-November 9.



PreACT 8/9

PreACT 8/9 on our Kansas contract is for **grade 9 only**.

- Ordering is done through the College and Career Readiness Information System(CCRIS). Instructions are provided on the Kansas ACT website in Step 2 under the PreACT 8/9 tab. Select “Kansas” from the “Choose Program” drop down menu.
- You may only order within the ordering window; August 24-October 2. PreACT 8/9 is only available on paper for the Kansas contract.
- No student enrollment required.
- The test window is September 28-October 23.
- Answer documents received after November 6 will not be scored.

If you wish to test grade 8 students, the process is different. Do NOT order through CCRIS. Contact Kim Rasmussen kim.rasmussen@act.org for guidance. Your district will be invoiced for grade 8 tests scored.

 - Deadline for submissions for Test Window 1 is January 15, 2027.
 - Deadline for submissions for Test Window 2 is February 24, 2027
 - Deadline for submissions for Test Window 3 is March 10, 2027
- Pearson Access will open for test date selection and enrollment on November 9.
