

Security and Ethics Training

- All District Test Coordinators must complete *in-person* Security and Ethics training held by KSDE and train staff before testing.
- All *in-person district training* must be completed by **January 16, 2026** for anyone administering a **KELPA** assessment
- All *in-person district training* must be completed by **March 13, 2026** for anyone administering a **KAP** assessment in ELA, Math, Science, and/or cPass.

***These dates may vary depending on the needs of your district. Please note that **all staff** administering summative assessments must complete Security and Ethics training **before** the testing windows open.



Security and Ethics Training

- Documentation of training should be kept at the building and district level.



Special Circumstance Codes

- SC-11 KELPA and WIDA Alt ACCESS only
 - Fill out the form for approval from KSDE.
 - Access form from Educator Portal.
 - Go to the KELPA Assessment.
 - Help > Special Circumstance Code > KELPA and WIDA Special Circumstance Request Form
- SC-08 and SC-39
 - Fill out application for approval from KSDE and email to Chelsea Pelfrey.
 - Access application from any assessment program in Educator Portal.
 - Help > Special Circumstance



Special Circumstance Codes

- All Special Circumstance Codes must be entered before the end of the testing window for the assessment it is requested for.
 - You will not enter a code anywhere for WIDA. That will be taken care of after the window closes by KSDE.



Kite Student Portal Updates

- 2025-26: Kite Student Portal remains **version 11.0.0**
- Quit Passwords
 - Remain the same as the previous year for each device type

- Chromebook App for 2026-27
 - New app coming for next school year!

TASC Records and Rosters

Reminders

1. Students can be on multiple rosters of the same subject
2. Students can be manually removed from rosters created with a TASC record
3. Students can be removed from any subject roster but must remain on at least one for the subject
 - a. *Example: If a student is on 3 ELA rosters, they can be removed from 2 of them*
4. Students can only be added to KAP rosters through KIDS with a TASC record

How to remove a student from a roster

Settings > Rosters > Enter Search Criteria > Select Search > Select the Roster > uncheck the box next to the student you wish to remove > Select Save



Interim Test Window

- Spring Interim Test Window: January 12 – February 6, 2026
- Individual Student Reports are available within 15 min of student completing the test

Reminder for Spring Interim!

- Option for your district to complete testing early
 - Why?
 - Final results for your district prior to Feb 6th
 - Reports generated for students left in progress
 - How?
 - DTC must contact the Kite Service Desk and let them know the desired end date for the district

- You can now build your own Instructional Mini Test combining items from multiple existing Mini Tests
- Download & complete the Excel Spreadsheet from the HELP Tab in EP
- Email the completed document to ats_management_dl@ku.edu
 - Kite will build your Mini Test and alert you once it is available in EP
- Reminders!
 - Must be from the same subject
 - Cannot combine ELA, Math and Science items
 - Must be from the same grade
 - Cannot combine different grade levels
 - Group Math items by Calculator Status

NAEP Practice Tests – Coming soon!

- NAEP tests are scheduled for administrations in select districts/schools in January – March 2026.
- To allow for easier access to NAEP Practice Tests, Kite will provide sample practice items in Kite, available as Instructional Mini Tests.



ELA Spring Interim Instructional Mini Tests

Coming Soon!

- Features:
 - Two passage-based blocks of items
 - One literary passage and one informational passage
 - Eight items per passage – mixed reading and writing
 - Truncated Interim 2 blueprint
- Designed to be taken before or after the Spring Interim assessment to support student instruction.
- Targeted release: Prior to January 15th




Desmos Calculator – Coming soon!

- TI Calculators will continue to be available in Kite Student Portal.
- Desmos Calculators are being added to Instructional Mini Tests, and the Practice tests.



DLM Monitoring

- Dashboard
 - First Contact Survey Status
 - not started, in progress, ready to submit, and completed
 - Testing Outside Hours
 - Short Duration Testing
- Reports – Data Extracts – Test Administration and Monitoring
 - DLM Instructionally Embedded Monitoring - Monitor this extract to ensure blueprint requirements are met for both ELA and Math
 - TIP Access – This extract identifies if the teacher accessed the testlet information page prior to administering the testlet. **This is required.**

Accessing the Testlet Information Page

- Teachers need to access from the Instruction and Assessment Planner for each testlet prior to administering.

Initial Precursor: Communicate understanding of "separateness" by recognizing objects that are not joined together. Communicate understanding of set by recognizing a group of objects sharing an attribute.





