Important Upcoming Dates

- March 13
 - In-person Test Security and Ethics Training Completed with agreements signed
 - TEST records uploaded for the General Summative Assessments
 - PNPs updated and ready for testing
 - TASC records uploaded for Grade 2 Reading Assessment
 - KELPA and WIDA Alt ACCESS Testing Windows Close
 - Postmark date to return WIDA Alt ACCESS Materials is March 25
- March 23
 - In-Person General Summative Assessment Window Opens
- April 6
 - KELPA Scoring Window Closes



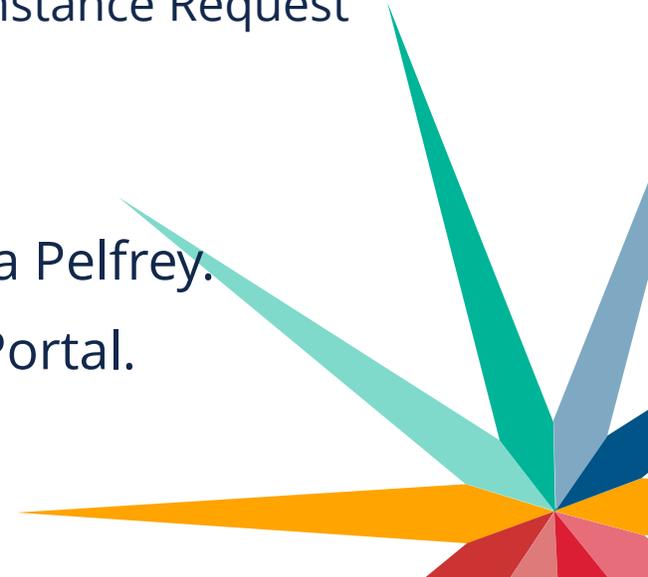
Special Circumstance Codes

- All Special Circumstance Codes must be entered before the end of the testing window for the assessment it is requested for.
 - You will not enter a code anywhere for WIDA. That will be taken care of after the window closes by KSDE.
- SC codes should be used in extreme circumstances and are not widely available.
- In most cases, an attempt should be made to assess the student before requesting an SC code.



Special Circumstance Codes

- SC-11 KELPA and WIDA Alt ACCESS only
 - Reserved for those students who **cannot** complete one domain due to a **disability** such as not being able to speak.
 - Fill out the form for approval from KSDE.
 - Access form from Educator Portal.
 - Go to the KELPA Assessment.
 - Help > Special Circumstance Code > KELPA and WIDA Special Circumstance Request Form
- SC-08 and SC-39
 - Fill out application for approval from KSDE and email to Chelsea Pelfrey.
 - Access application from any assessment program in Educator Portal.
 - Help > Special Circumstance



Unique Accommodations

- If you have a unique situation and accommodation request for a student, please email cary.rogers@ksde.gov or call Cary Rogers at 785-296-0916 to discuss the student's specific needs.
 - We do have a Unique Accommodations form that we will provide to the DTC after the initial conversation.



TTS Passages and Graphics

- Text-to-Speech Passages and Graphics Applications
 - All applications have been reviewed and sent back to the DTC with approved/disapproved stamp.
 - **Make sure the PNP is set to TTS Passages and Graphics. We had 404 students approved who did not have PNPs set by March 5th, These should have been set by February 26th**
 - Approvals in Kite for those students has started.
 - If a student was disapproved, make sure TTS passages and graphics is not set on the student's PNP.



TTS Passages and Graphics

- **Double check your SIS system to ensure students are marked correctly for WD (with disability) or a 504 plan for all students with submitted applications.**
- Check to make sure this is all completed before leaving for Spring Break.



Testing Violations

- In the event of a testing violation, please report to Chelsea Pelfrey.
- KSDE Testing Violation Report
 - Help > Testing Violation Report > KSDE Testing Violation Report
 - Fill out the form and submit.
 - KSDE will respond within 48 hours with a resolution to the violation.



Personally Identifiable Information (PII)

- Student PII should never be shared via email or Live Chat.
- Violations have been reported from the Kite Service Desk.
- Remember
 - Only include the student state ID number when referencing a specific student.
 - Never share the student's full name, grade, building, or district.
 - Make sure to remind your teachers of this, as we know that they may need to reach out for support.



Grade 11 Science Summative

- Test will be administered this year.
- Standard Setting will take place over the summer.
- Scores will be released Fall 2026 once the State Board of Education approves the new cut scores.
- **Reminder! Summative assessments contain 2 sessions and should be administered over the course of 2 days. Please do not administer both sessions in one sitting.**



Grade 2 Reading Assessment

- Window 3/23-4/24/2026
- Measures both foundational reading skills and early reading comprehension
- TASC record required for students to test
- Administered through the Kite Student Portal

Schools that administer the Grade 2 Reading Assessment gain actionable information that can be used to:

- **Identify gaps in foundational literacy skills**
- **Monitor trends**
- **Ensure preparedness for grade 3 reading expectations**, where comprehension demands increase



TEST Record Guidance

- Who to include?
 - Students who are enrolled in an assessed grade level (3-8, 10, 11)
- Do not include
 - ELA record for students who recently arrived in US after 3/23/25.
 - Homeschool students who only attend the public school for electives or special education services
 - Students who arrive after the need not test date of March 23.
 - This date does not apply to in district movement.

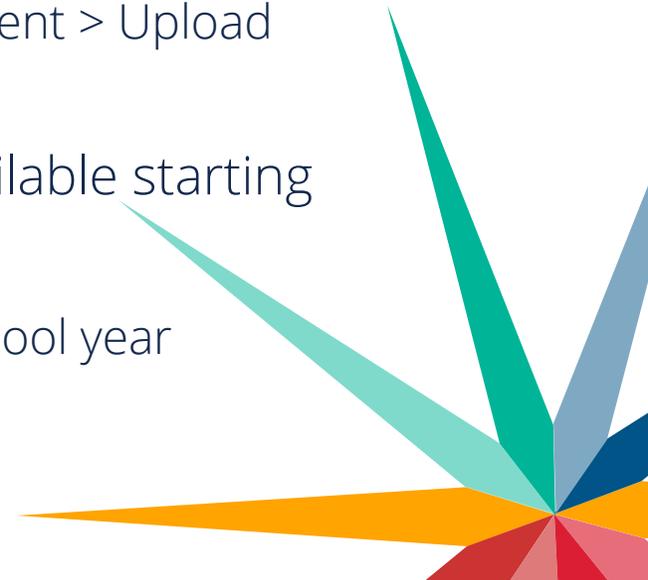

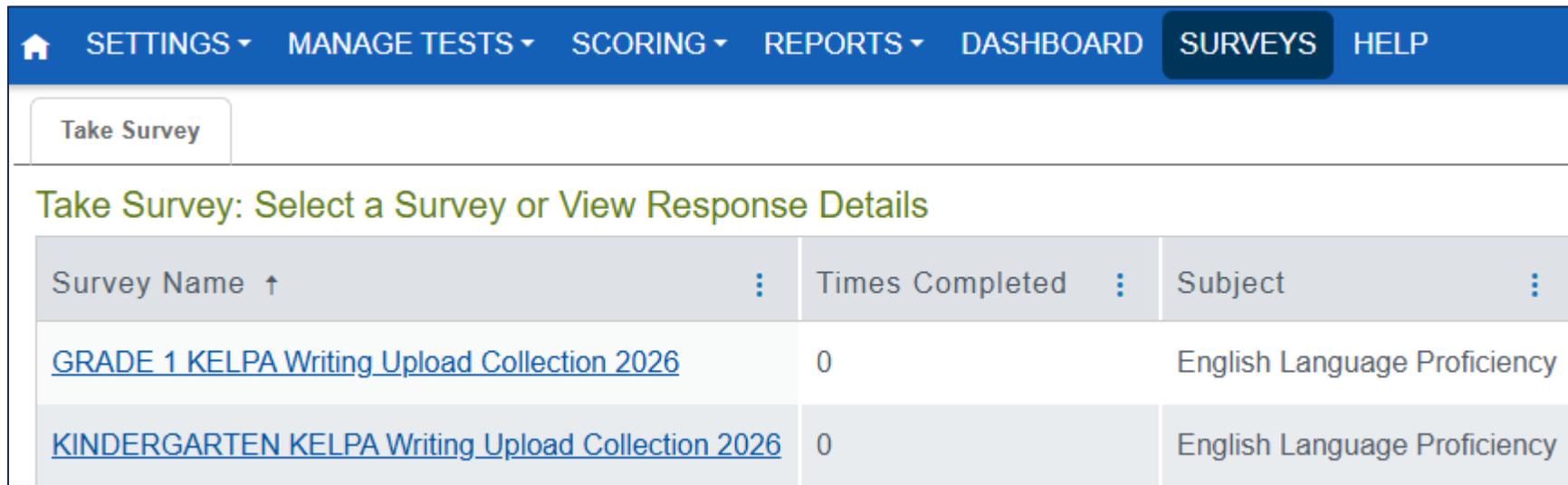
KELPA Screener

- Reminder:
 - Add **State Student Identifier (SSID)** to KELPA Screener students
 - Connects Screener Student to TEST Enrollment Record
 - Retains KELPA Screener proficiency report associated with the SSID
 - Two ways to add the SSID
 - Manually: Settings > Screener Student > View Student > Edit
 - Upload/Link Student: Settings > Screener Student > Upload/Link Student > Upload updated KELPA Screener Student file
 - The "KELPA Screen for next academic year" check box will be available starting March 23rd
 - Use this check box if you are screening a student for the following school year



Writing Booklets

- Required only for Grade K and Grade 1
 - Writing booklets are found in the HELP tab in EP
- Writing booklets must be submitted in the Surveys tab in EP before the end of the scoring window, which ends April 6th

Second Rater Scoring

- Schools with 10 or more EL (English Learner) students at a grade/grade band are randomly selected for double scoring.
- Educators are not assigned for second rater scoring in EP
- It is up to the District / School to determine who will complete the secondary scoring
 - Allows for added flexibility
 - District and Building level users have access to score all students in the building
 - Teachers completing second rater scoring will require an additional scoring assignment to be created.



Second Rater Scoring Cont.

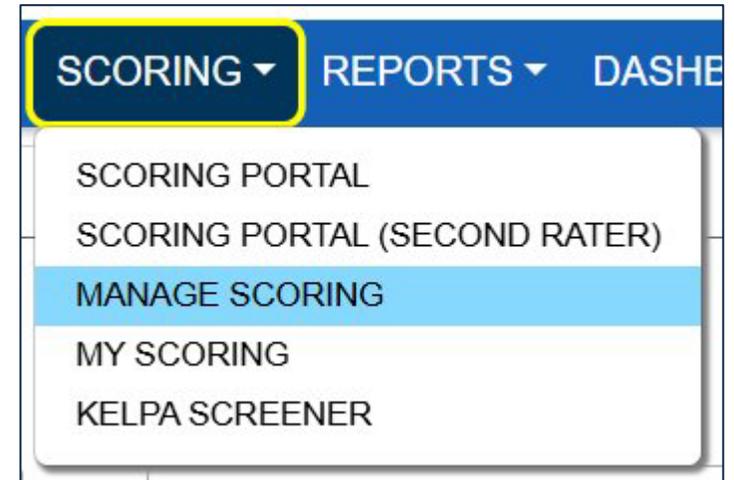
- How do I see students marked for 2nd rater?
 - Reports > Data Extracts > Select the Test Administration and Monitoring tab > Select "New file" in the Monitor Scoring row > Open the file
 - Review **column N (Rater)**. This column will state Secondary if the student is flagged as requiring 2nd rater scoring.

Second Rater Scoring Cont.

- How do I create an additional scoring assignment for a 2nd rater?
 - As a Building or District level user:
 - Scoring > Manage Scoring > Assign Scorers. Complete the required fields and select Search
 - Select the students to be scored > select Add > select the Scorer > select Add > select Save, and then Done.
 - **Reminder:** Once a scoring assignment is created, manually it cannot be deleted. If it was created in error, there is no harm in leaving it in the system.



Special Circumstance Codes

- Two options to apply SC codes for KELPA manually
 - 1.) Test Session (Existing option)
 - 2.) Student
- SC-11 is now restricted in EP to be applied to **one** domain
 - If entered on 2 or more domains
 - Manually – Receive a pop-up error message
 - Upload – Row on upload will be rejected

Guide to KAP Instructional Mini Test Reports

KAP Instructional Mini Test reports provide immediate, actionable insight into student performance at the test, item and standards level. Reports are designed to support instruction, student reflection, and progress monitoring throughout the school year.

Choosing the Right Report

If You Want To...	Use This Report
See overall class performance	Test Summary Report
Analyze one student's answers	Student Test Report
Identify difficult questions	Test Items Report
Review answers with students	Feedback Report
Track participation across subjects	Student Activity Report
Monitor standards mastery	Standards Based Report

Test Summary Report
Best for: Quick class overview
How to Access: Interim > View Results > Instructional Report (tab) > Test Summary
Available Formats: Online view; CSV export
What it shows:

- Overall student scores
- Class averages
- Points earned vs. possible points
- Item-level score totals

When to use it:

- Immediately after testing
- To identify overall class strengths and weaknesses
- To determine if reteaching is needed for the whole group

Instructional Use: Start here. This report indicates whether the class generally mastered the content of the Mini Test or if reteaching is needed before moving forward.

Student Test Report
Best for: Individual student analysis
How to Access: Interim > View Results > Instructional Report (tab) > Student Test
Available Formats: Online view; CSV export
What it shows:

- Each student's responses
- Correct answers
- Points earned per item
- Total score and percent correct

When to use it:

- During PLCs or data meetings
- When planning small-group instruction
- For parent conversations

Instructional Use: Identify patterns in errors. Look for misconceptions, not just incorrect responses.

Grade 2 Reading

- Test Tickets and Monitoring Testing
 - Manage test > Test Coordination
- Score reports are available after the window is closed
- Available Score Reports
 - Student Score Report (Individual/Bundled) - PDF Report
 - Areas assessed and the student score in each area
 - Second Grade Reading Report Extract – CSV Report
 - Brief description of the item
 - How each student responded - correctly (C), incorrectly (I), or did not respond (N/A)
 - Second Grade Reading Results – CSV Report
 - Summary information about the structure and scoring by student for each area assessed



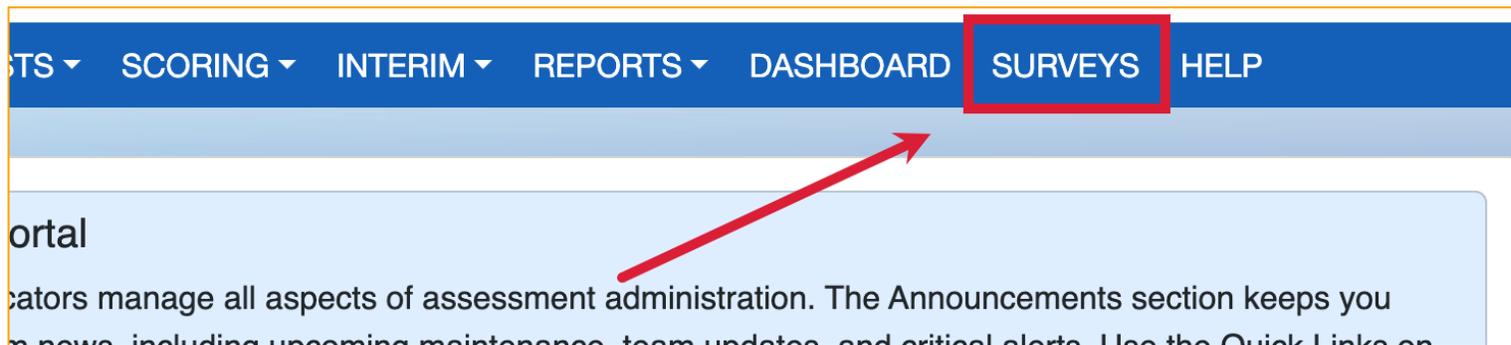
Technical Support

- Having Testing Issues?
 - Reach out to the Service Desk:
 - WHO:
 - The user/teacher of the student **directly** experiencing the issue
 - WHAT:
 - Device Make, Model, and OS (Ex: Acer Chromebook 314, 144.0.7559.102)
 - Student + Test + Item (if applicable)
 - Extra features in use (touch screen, tablet mode, external screen, Bluetooth mouse)
 - WHEN:
 - If affecting ability to test, call us **as soon as possible**.
 - If a restart or log out/in allows the student to continue, gather the info and submit after

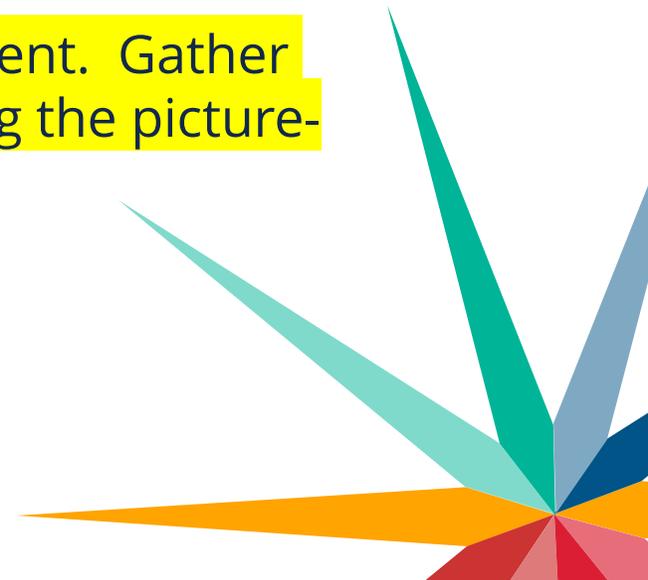
Spring Test Window – ELA and Math

- ELA and math are instructionally embedded
 - Teachers must create instructional plan and assign testlet once instruction is complete.
 - Make sure teachers understand how to meet the blueprint requirements.
 - Encourage use of [Kansas Essential Elements Blueprint/Selection Record - Math and English Language Arts by Grade](#) (PDF).
 - Student may receive 0 or 1 field test per subject. Encourage teachers to have students complete these.
- Review Testlet Information Page (TIP) access for the fall test window
 - Make sure teachers understand the importance of accessing the TIP
 - Make sure they know how to access the TIP



Spring Test Window - Science

- 9 science testlets per student (grades 5, 8, and 11)
- The system chooses the EE from the blueprint and selects the linkage level – based on the first contact survey. Teachers cannot change the linkage level.
- Linkage levels are adjusted by the system based on the student’s performance on the pervious testlet.
- Students will only receive one testlet at a time. You must wait up to 30 minutes for the next testlet to appear.
- Retrieve the Testlet Information Page for testlet in Test Management. Gather needed materials before beginning assessment, including printing the picture-response cards when needed (initial linkage level)



Science Field Testing

- Field testing for the new 2027 Science DLM Assessment
 - Each student will receive 4 field test items
 - Bundled as 2 testlets
- Every student grade 5, 8, and 11 will receive 4 science field test testlets.
 - 2 batches with 2 testlets
- Teachers are asked to administer both batches of science field test testlets.
 - This is necessary for the new science assessment that will be operational in 2027.
- Testlet Information Pages for field test testlets are accessed in the Test Management section.
