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## KAP summative tests for ELA, Math, Science and HGSS

- Testing Window **3-13-18 to 4-27-18**
- Daily Access Code – will be available at 2:00 the day before.
- **Test Tickets** – we do not have test tickets. You can create your own test tickets. Download the Test Readiness extract to obtain usernames and passwords.
- **HGSS** scoring materials are available. These materials provide specific guidelines and procedures for HGSS scoring. Materials are posted on the HELP tab in the Educator Portal.
  - All HGSS scoring must be completed by May 11
  - HGSS Scoring Materials\_2018
  - KITE HGSS Scoring Manual – this document is not a test secure document.
- **Calculator use** (applies for both science and math): Refer to pages 27-28 of the KAEM.
  - Students in grades 6, 7, and 8 are limited to using a **scientific calculator**.
  - Students in grade 10 are limited to using a **scientific calculator or a graphing calculator**.
  - If students choose to use a handheld calculator, the **memory must be cleared** both before AND after each testing session.
  - Keep a **record** of each student using a handheld calculator. At the break between calculator active and calculator-inactive parts, collect handheld calculators from students.

## Interim

### Predictive:

- Fall – 81, 551 assessments were administered.
- Winter – 108,154 assessments were administered.
- Spring – 101, 949 assessments were administered.

### Mini-tests:

- Additional mini-tests have been added to the interim site.
- The interim system will remain open throughout the summative window.
- 83,506 mini-tests have been administered so far this year!
- Mini tests are not designed as “practice” for the state assessment, but should be used as a formative assessment to determine what students have learned and still need to learn.

## **Technology: Chromebook**

The ATS Service Desk would like to remind you of the proper way to test using a Chromebook. The only supported and secure method for testing with a Chromebook is by launching the app in Kiosk Mode.

This is done by doing the following steps:

Have the student logout of the Chromebook  
Check to make sure the Chromebook is connected to the internet  
Click "Apps" on the lower left corner of the login page  
Select KITE Client out of the list

Not testing using Kiosk Mode can compromise test security.

### **Highlighter tool on touchscreen Chromebooks:**

- The ATS KITE Service Desk is aware that the **highlighter tool** does not work on touchscreen Chromebooks.
- The ATS development team is currently looking into this and we hope to have a resolution out as soon as possible.
- The highlighter is functioning on all supported non-touchscreen Chromebooks, iPads, Macs, and Windows devices.
